BEING A MEMBER OPENS DOORS TO:

Open Training

A great way for those who have enjoyed club training to step up to the next level and learn to race alongside other Topper sailors in a friendly and supportive atmosphere, under the guidance of experienced RYA coaches and previous Topper champions; and for experienced Topper sailors to refine their skills and racing techniques.

Regional Racing Events (“Travellers”)

Regular one day racing events at clubs and venues near you. These are open to sailors of all abilities and sailing with either 4.2 or 5.3 sails, with prizes at every event and for the overall series. A wonderful way to put your training into practice, meet other sailors and their families in your area and make new friends at the same time.

National Championships

A week-long event each summer holidays open to all our members with racing in 5.3 Fleet, 4.2 Fleet and also a Regatta Fleet (for the very youngest/novice sailors who are just learning how to race).

National Series Racing

Fast, fun and competitive racing at venues around the country between February and October each year. We have six National Series weekend events (each one a two day event) with racing in two separate fleets for the 5.3 and 4.2 sailors. A chance for you to race in a larger fleet and test your skills. Open to all members from National Squad sailors to those just starting out, they provide competitive racing in a supportive, fun environment.

World Championships

A chance to combine your love of sailing with seeing some other parts of the world, your ITCA (GBR) membership allows you to enter the World Championships and compete against Topper sailors from across the globe.

Opportunities for a Squad Place

We work with the RYA to develop sailing potential with Regional Training Groups, alongside ITCA (GBR) 4.2 and ITCA (GBR) 5.3 National Squads run by the Class itself. So there is an option for all members with a range of abilities and experience catered for.
