



Volunteer Rib Custodian

Role Description

What the role involves:

- Towing the rib to and from the National Series events / National Championships around the country, and training weekends by negotiation.
- Ensuring that both the rib and trailer are functioning and safe/roadworthy at all times.
- Arranging for any repairs/maintenance work to be done promptly.
- Arranging for Engine service by Approved Yamaha dealer in Feb or March each year and maybe a second service if excessive use ie, if more than 100 hours per year.
- Liaising with ITCA GBR rib master about use at events and ITCA GBR secretary about costs/expenses.

ITCA GBR:

- Pay for maintenance and repair bills on receipt of appropriate invoice, by BACS transfer, or will pay suppliers direct by prior arrangement.
- Insure the rib and trailer on the water and in transit.
- Provide kit on board, including a sharp knife, whistle, first aid kit.
- Provide guidance on safety procedures on and off the water.
- Provide public liability insurance whilst you are on the water as long as you are adhering to the agreed policies.
- Pay mileage for towing the rib to events (53p per mile) and cost of fuel on the water (on production of a receipt). You may be requested to re fuel off site if on site facilities are deemed too expensive.

You need to:

- Have a current PB2 licence (coastal) and to provide a copy of this for ITCA GBR records if you would like to drive it at events/training.
- Check the boat and trailer regularly for wear and tear.
- Keep the boat and trailer in a secure location, using the wheel lock and hitch lock as additional security.
- Arrange for remedial work to be carried out by a reputable company.
- Notify the rib master and secretary of any work which needs carrying out and have authorisation for work before it commences.
- Ensure your vehicle insurance covers Third Party Claims whilst you are towing.
- Agree to only use the rib at events authorised by ITCA GBR. It is not insured for any other uses.

Skills/experience needed

- Well organised
- Flexible and willing to work as part of a team
- Have a positive attitude and be prepared to deal with last minute changes
- Be able to check e-mails etc regularly and respond
