Time Commitment:

- Work from home at times to suit you
- Liaise with the RYA Safeguarding team
- Participate in the AGM
- Participate in monthly committee meetings

What the role involves:

- Ensuring that any policies regarding safeguarding are kept up-to-date
- Presenting information / policies / recommendations from the RYA Safeguarding Team to the ITCA (GBR) Committee
- Ensure that everyone is aware of the need for safeguarding and address any incidents when best practice is not being followed
- Be aware of the relevant legislation
- Liaise with the RYA Safeguarding Team when concerns arise

Skills/experience needed:

- Enhanced DBS check (this will be organised and paid for through the RYA & ITCA (GBR))
- Have completed the RYA Safe & Fun course and the RYA welfare officer course (this will be paid for by ITCA (GBR))
- Good communication skills
- Discretion– due to the nature of the role
