

Southern alignment has caused confusion and adjusted the areas



- Running Class squads for 4.2 and Youth sailors to complement the RYA pathway ones.


To encourage a lifelong love of the sport of sailing.


We will do this by:

2015 5.3 Event Analysis









4.2 Event Analysis







Recent Changes to Racing

- Increase to 10x 30 min races for National Series events
 - More starting practice
 - Closer racing throughout the fleet
- Shorter start lines
 - Improve starting techniques
- Tougher penalties for forgetting to tally out
- Changes to the qualification series at the Nationals
 - Ensuring sailors sail against each other
 - Allowing coaches time with sailors between races
